### **CALL TO ORDER – February 22, 2006**

Meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Chairman, Joe Jaynes in the Auditorium of the OB Library.

### **MINUTES**

Kristee Booth provided the correct spelling for her name and the correct name of her company for the January minutes. Martin Press moved to approve the minutes with the correction. The motion was seconded by Rita Press. All members present voted to approve. Results of action items from January are discussed below.

### **CAG BUSINESS**

Joe Jaynes contacted Nancy Prasse of the Metropolitan Planning Organization and arranged to make a presentation on March 28 to show the video and provide a status update on our progress. He will request a resolution of support from MPO.

Joe clarified the copyright issue, stating that a copyright is automatically granted to the person who did the work. Ms. Lackey gave Joe a copy of the video tape and a DVD. Joe had nine copies of the DVD made for distribution to interested parties. Laureen needs one for the County file. We will have additional DVD copies made. **Action Item: Rita Press will ask Save The Loop to reimburse Joe Jaynes for the costs of copying the individual DVDs.** Save The Loop will not pay for copies of the video tape and the DVD s required for County, City and FDOT.

The CAG video was shown to County Council at the 9:00 a.m. meeting on February 2. Joe provided background information and a status report to the Council. Dr. Wilton from DBCC, BJ Lackey and Rick Smith attended the presentation. It was well received by County Council.

The City of Ormond Beach will view the videotape at the March 7 meeting.

Joe Jaynes requested time on the March 15 agenda of East Central Florida Regional Planning Council (ECFRPC) – Trails and Greenway. He has not yet received confirmation.

Rita Press recommends speaking to as many civic and community organizations as possible; i.e.: Rotary, Chamber of Commerce. She recently spoke to a meeting of GE Women and provided a status update on our activities and requested a resolution of support from their organization. **Action Items: Rita will work on a committee to identify a few people to make these presentations. Dorothy Pflieger and Gen Schwarz will show the video to the Ormond Beach Garden Club. Paula Wehr will contact our webmaster to learn if the DVD can be added to the website for viewing directly from the internet. Benny Woodham will distribute Corridor Impressions Surveys and Petitions of Support to park visitors during Bike Week.**

Joe attended the Historic Ormond-by-the-Sea Scenic Trail (HOSST) CAG meeting on February 8, 2006. He provided a report on their progress to date and noted that HOSST requested that we merge our roadways and our CAGs. The merging of roadways from both CAGs will complete The Loop, as well as add sections of Highbridge Road and A1A. Marty Press made a motion that “The two groups remain autonomous and find ways to cooperate on issues and projects of common interest.” Bill Mazanec seconded the motion. Following discussion of all issues, a vote was taken. Consultants, staff and OBTS did not vote. The motion failed.

**Action Item:** The consultants will draft recommended procedures on how to merge the two CAGs for discussion at the March 22 meeting.
