MINUTES

The names of Forest Michael and Garry Balogh were incorrectly spelled in the May minutes. Laura Bamberger moved to approve the minutes from 5/24/06 with corrections. The motion was seconded by Sue Parkerson. All members present voted to approve.

UPDATE FROM THE CHAIR

Joe Jaynes reported that the final version of the Ormond Beach Scenic Loop Eligibility Application was signed by CAG Chair Joe Jaynes, Mayor Fred Costello, County Chairman Frank Bruno and Mary Martin of MPO. Review of our application is on the SHAC agenda for Thursday, July 20 at 3:15 p.m. at Environmental Management Office, Burns Building, OPP/EMO Meeting Room, located at 605 Suwannee Street, Tallahassee. We received a letter of support from Ormond Beach Chamber of Commerce for the OB Scenic Loop CAG as a result of Joe's presentation a few weeks ago. Kristee Booth mentioned that we must provide new letters of support for the Corridor Management Plan during the Designation Phase. **Action: Joe will request that Marty Press provide a list of all organizations and individuals who sent letters of support earlier. Paula will write to each one requesting a second letter of support for the Ormond Scenic Loop and Trail organization.**

CORRIDOR MANAGEMENT PLAN

Several suggestions were made to revise the Corridor Story. **Action: Sue Parkerson will double check one historical fact and confirm the correct information to Kristee Booth. Teri Holleran has digital pictures which she will forward to Kristee and Wes Hoaglund. Forest Michael will insert the map pieces into the Corridor Story; Wes will insert the photos. Rich Smith will provide information on the Addison Block House and the McGrane Plantation which will be added to the Corridor Story. The consultants will distribute the revised version at or prior to the July meeting.**

Rob Byrd provided a different version of the Corridor Vision, incorporating many of the thoughts of the previous version in a different format. The group made only minor suggestions for change and adopted the Corridor Vision as written by Rob.

Wes reviewed the revisions, additions and deletions to the Goals, Objectives and Strategies document that were submitted to him earlier by CAG members. The group discussed and accepted many of the suggestions. **Action: Wes will incorporate all the revisions agreed upon by the attendees on Wednesday evening and will provide the revised version at or prior to the July meeting.**

CONSULTANT UPDATE

Kristee reminded CAG members to work on by-laws. Both the original HOSST group and the OB Scenic Loop had begun working on by-laws documents. These documents will become the basis for the OSLT By-Laws.

Forest Michael distributed copies of Part I of the Action Plan along with a draft map of the Bicycle Pedestrian Concept Plan..
