CALL TO ORDER – July 26, 2006

Meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Chairman, Joe Jaynes in the Auditorium of the OB Library.

MINUTES

Martin Press moved to approve the minutes from 6/28/06 as written. The motion was seconded by Rita Press. All members present voted to approve.

UPDATE FROM THE CHAIR

Joe Jaynes reported the OSLT Eligibility Application was reviewed by SHAC on Thursday, July 20 and was approved 6-0. Kristee Booth was present during the review via teleconference. She provided a brief summary of comments from SHAC members. See the following.

- Ormond Yacht Club- listed in 2005, may be moved or demolished soon
- Archaeology- interpretation of these resources within the State Park should be away from the site but within the park, possibly in a supervised area
- Does the County Comp Plan include preservation elements for historic resources and buffers for development? If not, we should add them.
- Identify more cultural events. **Action: Rita Press and Benny Woodham will create a list of events which take place on or along OSLT roadways. Rita will check the OB Chamber of Commerce event calendar as well.**
- Safety is a big issue- will need to talk about how to resolve this issue in CMP
- Look at the Comp Plan to provide protection techniques and Overlay District
- FHWA has comments to add to CMP that she provided to Andrew Nichol, Carter-Burgess
- SHAC members like The Loop and commend our efforts to protect it from development. They also thought the Eligibility Application was well done.

SHAC members were very impressed with the video, both the content and the length, and were especially pleased that we partnered with our local college. They encouraged other CAGs to forge similar partnerships. On July 27, Lauren Kornell notified Dr. Wilton of DBCC that our application was approved and thanked him for his assistance and the valuable work of his students.

We received letters of support from Halifax River Audubon and Shadow Woods Neighborhood Association, Inc. (homeowners association at Halifax Plantation) to be included with the CMP. In response to the action item from last meeting, Marty Press provided a list of all organizations and individuals who sent letters of support earlier.

Action: Paula will write to each one requesting a second letter of support for the Ormond Scenic Loop and Trail organization.

CONSULTANT UPDATE

Paper copies of the Corridor Story, with all revisions from last month, was distributed. Paula Wehr moved to approve and accept this final version. Richard Gardner seconded. The motion was unanimously approved. **Action:** Teri Holleran is searching City records for digital pictures to include with the Corridor Story. In addition, all CAG members who have appropriate photos are requested to forward them to Kristee and Wes.

Paper copies of the revisions, additions and deletions to the Goals, Objectives and Strategies document were distributed. Paula Wehr moved to accept this version as written; Richard Gardner seconded. The motion was unanimously approved. **Action:** Paula will provide electronic copies of the OSLT Vision and Corridor Story to the webmaster for posting on the web site.

A discussion ensued regarding the elements necessary to complete the Corridor Management Plan and the time needed to fulfill those requirements. The contract with our consultants runs to March 2007. The group agreed that we need an action plan. **Action:** Lauren and the consultants will create a schedule for presentation at the August meeting which will include CAG action items and the due dates for City and County approvals.

Kristee Booth reminded us we need to finalize the by-laws and the CME partnership agreement. **Action:** The By-Laws Committees from both the OB Scenic Loop and HOSST will re-convene to finalize a document for OSLT, ready for approval at the August meeting. Committee members are Joe Jaynes, Laura Bamberger, Richard Gardner, Marty Press, David Pellett and Paula Wehr.

Joan Carter, Bicycle Pedestrian Coordinator for FDOT made a presentation on funding issues for alternative transportation issues.

Forest Michael distributed revised copies of Part I of the Action Plan along with a revised map of the Bicycle Pedestrian Concept Plan. **Action:** All CAG members are requested to either bring their amendments to Table 1 - Corridor Enhancements to the August meeting or to e-mail the revisions to winterpark1@earthlink.net.

MEMBER COMMENTS

Marty Press recommends that we create a Grants Coordinator position. Most grant applications must be requested through a government agency prior to us obtaining non-profit status. After we achieve non-profit status, we will be able to request grants on our own behalf.
